

## CERTIFICATE IN NONPROFIT MANAGEMENT



### The Basics

The Nonprofit Management Certificate Program increases the skills, knowledge and abilities of professionals, board members, and volunteers working in the nonprofit field. Participants build a network of peers in the sector and nonprofit organizations increase their capacity.

This 12-month program utilizes a hybrid learning model with online courses and facilitated cohort meetings.

Graduates earn the following educational credits:

- ▶ CFRE: 42 points
- ▶ SHRM PDCs - 41
- ▶ PMI PDUs: 5
- ▶ IACET CEUs - 5 (Contact Hours - 5)
- ▶ HRCI - 29 credits

### Certificate Requirements

- ▶ Completion of 11 courses (estimated 44 hours) covering:
  - Board development
  - Fundraising
  - Financial management
  - Planning and evaluation
  - Leadership and ethics
  - Marketing and social media
- ▶ Live events:
  - Kick-off Summit
  - Ten (10) monthly cohort meetings
  - Closing Summit
- ▶ Other
  - Pre-assessment survey
  - Post-assessment survey
